All students are expected to:

Unacceptable behaviour will result first in a cooling off period, second in a phone call to your parents/guardians and lastly in a visit to the Principal's Office. Severe violations, such as fighting, extreme class disruption, or defiance will be referred to the Principal immediately for disciplinary action.
