


It's time for the Armed Services YMCA

Who can enter? Kindergarten through sixth grade children of Military Families in the Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, Coast Guard & National Guard/Reserves. The military parent must be active duty or retired (with 20+ years of service).

What to do? Drawings should be of the student's family and **in color on a 6 by 8 inch template**. Oversized and three-dimensional entries will not be judged. Entries should depict the student's military family. Please do not identify family members on the drawings.

Facts to know! Art contest Entry Forms are included in this packet and may also be found on our website: www.asymca.org and should be included with the entry. Entries without an Entry Form will not be judged, so make sure it is filled out completely and sent in with your artwork.

When is the deadline? All drawings *must be* postmarked by February 19, 2010.

Black and white drawings may be entered but are less likely to be selected as top winners. Oversized and three-dimensional entries will not be judged. Please do not identify family members on the drawing.

Winners must have a Social Security number to be issued bonds.


